ELIGIBILITY

Soho Photo Gallery of New York City is pleased to announce its 7th Annual Alternative Processes Competition. The competition is open to all U.S. residents, age 18 and older, excluding current members of Soho Photo Gallery. Alternative processes include (but are not limited to): Albumen, Cyanotype, Van Dyke Brown, Platinum/Palladium, Gum Bichromate, Bromoil, Salt Print, Tintype, Ziatype, Daguerreotype, Image Transfers, Liquid Emulsion, and Photogravure. Traditional Silver Gelatin Prints, C-Prints and Digital Prints are not eligible; however handmade prints created from digital negatives are welcome. We cannot accept free-standing work or images larger than 4 feet in any direction.

SUBMISSIONS

Photographs must be submitted online at spg.slideroom.com using only jpg, png or gif formats. For good image quality and fast upload, image files should be sized no larger than 1220 pixels @ 72 dpi.

DEADLINES

The deadline for all entries is **August 31st, 2011**. The photographers chosen by the juror will be notified by email before **September 10th**. The juror's selections will also be posted on the Soho Photo website by that date. Accepted work must arrive at the gallery by **October 10th**.

PRIZES

The juror will choose approximately 35 photographs for the exhibition. First, second and third place prizes will be awarded. At least two honorable mentions will be given at the discretion of the juror. Winning participants will be listed on our website: www.sohophoto.com.

WINNING PHOTOGRAPHS

Selected photographs must be framed and wired for hanging. We reserve the right to disqualify photographs that are not suitably prepared for hanging. Maximum height or width (including frame) of exhibited work cannot exceed 48 inches. Delivery instructions will be emailed to participants.

THE JUROR

Michael Paris Mazzeo is a gallerist, educator and photographer based in New York City. Since opening in 2005, the Michael Mazzeo Gallery has become one of the premier showcases of rising young talent in the field of photography, having awarded ten artists their first solo exhibitions in New York and including more than 100 others in group shows. Works by gallery artists have been acquired by major institutions including the Metropolitan Museum of Art, the Philadelphia Museum, the Victoria and Albert Museum, the Princeton Museum and Fidelity Investments, as well as by many private collectors. In seeking to promote the work of more artists, Michael recently initiated the RSVP project, an innovative series of curated online exhibitions, complete with on-demand published catalogs and e-commerce pages for photography collectors. Outside the gallery, Michael has curated exhibitions, organized and participated in panel discussions, and juried photography competitions. He serves on the faculties of the School of Visual Arts, the International Center of Photography, the New Jersey City University and has been a guest lecturer at other prestigious institutions. Michael has been a featured portfolio reviewer at FotoFest, Review Santa Fe, Photolucida, Critical Mass, FotoWeek DC, The Center of Photography at Woodstock, ICP, ASMP, SPE and powerHouse.
