Observation propels Aviva Baharav's rhythmic photographs. Through her lens, ordinary forms and objects become seas of moving shapes, giving daily life a dimension of mystery and changing the way we perceive our surroundings. Baharav also probes reality's subjectivity. Context changes our perception and seemingly insignificant objects, like raw materials, become alluring when Baharav imbues their nuances with a cadenced beauty.
