Tricia Rosenkilde, the juror of Soho Photo's **Third Annual Alternative Processes Competition**, awarded first prize to "Globe Stand," an ambrotype by Tom DeLooza of Ann Arbor, MI. She also chose second and third place winners plus one honorable mention. The 50 images on display include examples of other alternative processes such as cyanotype, VanDyke, platinum, palladium, Kwik Print®, gum bichromate, gumoil, calotype, bromoil, tintype, Daguerreotype, and Polaroid® transfer.

Rosenkilde, who was called "one of the top emerging photographers in the U.S." by Joyce Tennyson, spent several years traveling and living in Europe, Australia and India. She has taught alternative processes at New York's Parsons School of Design and the International Center of Photography.
