New York, N.Y. – Soho Photo Gallery is pleased to announce that in April 2007, the entire Gallery will be devoted to the twelfth Annual Members’ Juried Show called **SOHOPHOTO 2007**. For the first time, the members’ show is being held to coincide with TOAST— the annual Tribeca Open Artist Studio Tour—which is scheduled for April 27 through April 30.

The juror for this year's competition will be Michael Mazzeo, a New York City-based photographer, educator, and gallerist. He has photographed hundreds of commercial assignments over the past 15 years and his ambrotypes have been included in a number of exhibitions, including two at Soho Photo Gallery. Mazzeo teaches photography at Parsons School of Design and conducts Wet-Plate Collodion workshops at The Center for Photography at Woodstock, The Peters Valley Craft Education Center in New Jersey and at his Manhattan studio.

In 2005, Mazzeo founded Peer Gallery in Chelsea, which specializes in photography and related media. Peer's exhibitions have been featured in *The New York Times*, *The New Yorker*, *The Village Voice*, *L Magazine* and *The Photo District News*.

The work in **SOHOPHOTO 2007** will provide a unique opportunity to experience virtually the entire range of classic and contemporary photography—from pinhole, mixed media and digital photography to color, black and white, bleached and toned prints and those otherwise manipulated. One thing is certain: diversity will rule.

All the winners in **SOHOPHOTO 2007** will be clearly identified so that Gallery visitors will be able to compare their favorite choices with those of the juror, Michael Mazzeo. Last year's show had a wide variety of great work on display and this year's competition is sure to produce more of the same.
